


Whether you have a passion for the environment or want to support a local library, you can establish a fund or contribute to an existing fund through your estate plan to fulfill your philanthropic wishes.

Name Valley Community Foundation (VCF) in your will or trust for a specific percentage or amount, as a residual gift, or contingent gift.




Designate VCF as the beneficiary to an insurance policy, individual retirement account (IRA), 401k, or checking/savings account.



For another stream of income, create a
Charitable Gift Annuity and benefit from an
immediate tax break and guaranteed income
for life. Upon your passing, VCF receives the
remaining balance and fulfills your
philanthropic wishes.



Leverage the power of charitable remainder trusts or charitable lead trusts to perpetuate your values and your wealth for both your heirs and your charitable intentions.



## Establishing a Fund to Create your Legacy

You can set up a fund during your lifetime with little or no financial commitment and name the fund as a charitable beneficiary designation in your estate plan.

#### Donor Advised Funds —

A Donor Advised Fund gives you and your successor advisors the most flexibility by recommending grants to support nonprofits and issues you care about. A Donor Advised Fund is a wonderful vehicle to perpetuate your family values throughout future generations.

### Donor Designated Funds

If you want to support one or multiple nonprofit organizations, a Donor Designated Fund allows you to name nonprofits that will receive an annual gift from your Fund.

#### Scholarship Funds

Scholarship Funds are often created in memory of someone and enable you to help students pursue their academic ambitions or benefit a specific educational institution.

#### Preference Funds

Preference or Field of Interest Funds support evolving needs and a variety of nonprofits by focusing on an area of interest you are passionate about, such as education, environmental issues, healthcare, or a specific geographic area.

#### Unrestricted Funds

You can help address emerging issues in the Valley by creating an Unrestricted Fund, which allows us to make an impact as the needs in our communities change over time.

#### Testamentary Funds —

A Testamentary Fund is created during your lifetime and contains your philanthropic plan. You may have multiple charitable interests that you would like to leave as a charitable beneficiary in your estate. You name the fund at VCF in your estate plan and when we receive your assets we will carry out your wishes. Your plan can be modified at any time without the expense of an attorney.



# Join the Gates Society

Joining VCF's planned giving community is simple. Let us know you have named VCF or one of our funds in your estate plan so we can personally thank you during your lifetime.

The Society is named in honor of Ross and Frank Gates, the brothers of a prominent Derby family, from the 1900's. Ross and Frank created trusts in the family name to benefit the Valley in perpetuity.
